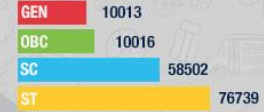

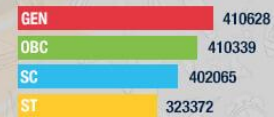

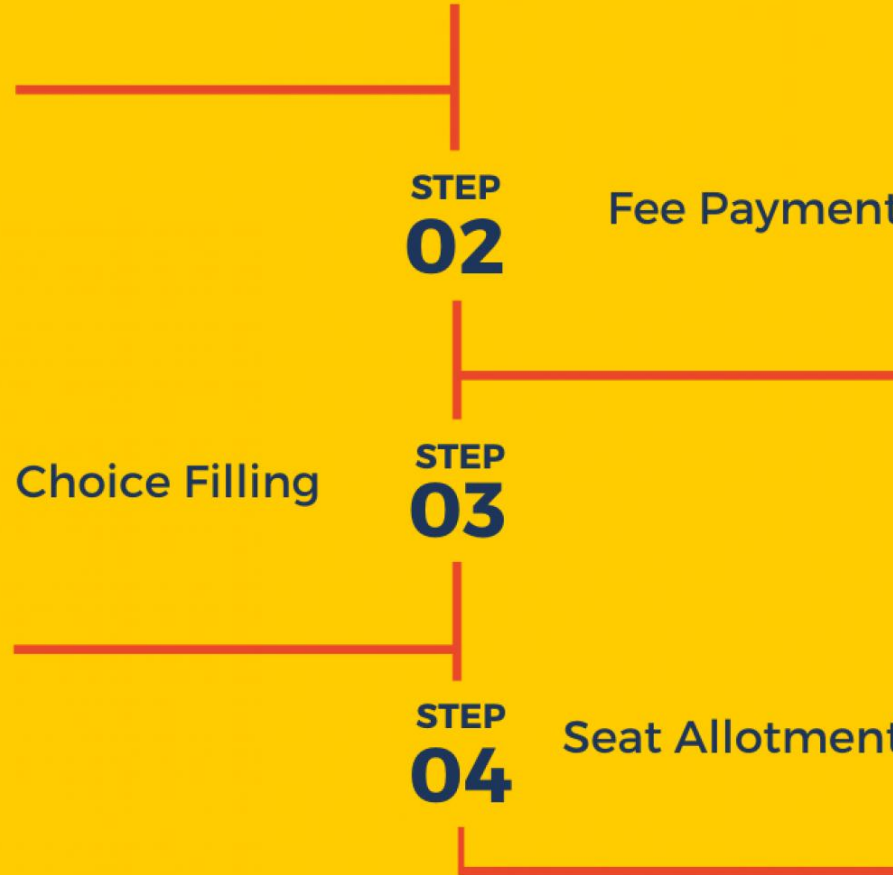

All India Quota (AIQ) Counseling – Procedure | Round 1 & Round 2

ROUND 1 –

Registration, Payment of Fees (Registration & Tuition fees) Submission of Choices, modify & locking of choices

First round of Seat Allotment

Report to the Allotted institute, Complete Admission formalities and give willingness as follows: (free exit/entry option available)

- Willingness for up-gradation in 2nd round YES/NO

Only Candidates who have given willingness as YES for up-gradation 2nd round

Display of newly added / vacant seats and also of anticipated vacancies (seats likely to be available after the conversion of vacant seats in category / subcategory and upgradation of previously allotted seats with newly offered seats)

Earlier choices submitted by candidate will be treated null and void. Fresh choices submission for seat allotment in Round 2 is mandatory

Candidates who have not been allotted any seat in Round 1
(or)

Free Exit Candidates (not satisfied with seat allotted in Round 1 and not reported to college) are eligible for participation in second round.

ROUND 2 –

Exercise fresh choices, view, modify and lock choices

Second round of allotment

Report to the Allotted institute, Complete Admission formalities.

Candidates joined in Round 2 will not be allowed to resign / leave the seat with forfeiture of security fees (Rs 10,000/-) within 2 days of publishing of Round 2 result.

Note: Non Joined/Not reported seats will be reverted back to the state Quota

Mop-up Round

Mop Up Round (Only for Deemed/ Central Universities, ESIC, AIIMS & JIPMER)

- Fresh Registration with payment of registration fee for Mop Up Round for the following candidates :
 - i. Those who registered in Round-1 & exited availing Free Exit
 - ii. Who registered in Round-2 & exited with Forfeiture of fees can register again with payment of fees.

However, candidates who have already joined and taken admission in Round-2 of AIQ/Deemed/ Central Universities/AIIMS/JIPMER will not be eligible to participate in Mop Up Round. (Those who registered but were not allotted a seat in Round-1 & Round-2 need not register again).

Candidates side -

- Fresh choice filling of Mop Up Round
- Await publication of result of Mop Up Round on MCC website
- Reporting at the Allotted Medical/ Dental College after Mop Up Round

Final Stray Vacancy Round

To be conducted by Deemed/ Central Universities/AIIMS/JIPMER

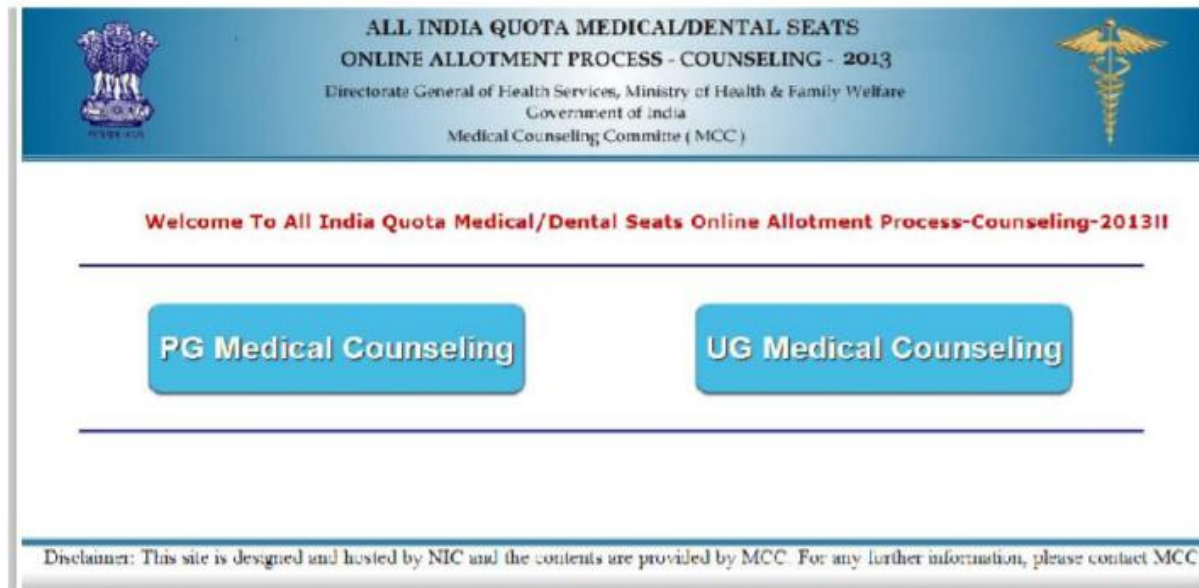

Qualified candidates are required to register on the MCC website i.e. www.mcc.nic.in to participate in the counselling process for allotment of seat.

Important Points

Candidates who accept seat in Round 2 AIQ will not be allowed to withdraw or surrender the seat allotment.

Candidates who wish to 'Exit' voluntarily after Round 1 must note that the security fee will not be refunded

Step 1	If the allotted seat is accepted, the candidate will have to download the NEET allotment letter 2021 by entering the roll number, date of birth, and security pin.
Step 2	Those allocate seats must report at the designated centres with documents and certificates for verification and completion of the admission process along with the NEET 2021 seat allotment letter.
Step 3	After the admission is granted, the allotted college will send the details of the candidate to DGHS and based on these details and the admission letter will be granted
Step 4	In case the candidate does not accept the seat after the first round of NEET 2021 seat allotment and don't wish to participate in NEET 2021 Counselling then free exit will be considered. This means that no refundable fees will be deducted. However, after the second round of counselling non-acceptance of the seat will lead to the deduction of refundable fees.
Step 5	If the candidate is not allotted a seat and wishes to participate in subsequent rounds of NEET 2021 Seat Allotment, they need to opt for the choices. Such candidates will also have to provide fresh choices for upcoming rounds of seat allotment. This option is only available only till the second round.

WHEREAS the candidate has, on his / her application been selected to undergo training for the M.B.B.S Course in the Government Medical College (hereinafter referred to as the said college).

AND WHEREAS the candidate has agreed to complete his / her training for the said course, at the said college , subject to the condition hereinafter appearing.

Now THEREFORE, this agreement witnesses and it is hereby agreed as follows.

- 01) The candidates shall diligently complete his / her training for the said course at the said college shall abide by the rules of the said college for the time being in force regulating the conduct of students at the said college and shall pass all the examinations prescribed for the said course by the University or the Medical Institution concerned.
- 02) Upon passing the final M.B.B.S Examination the candidate shall serve as 'intern' for the prescribed period as laid down by the Medical Council Act. 1956 (Central Act 102 of 1956)

- 02) Upon passing the final M.B.B.S Examination the candidate shall serve as 'intern' for the prescribed period as laid down by the Medical Council Act. 1956 (Central Act 102 of 1956)
- 03) i) The candidate shall on demand made by the Government within two years from the date of which he / she registers himself / herself as a Medical Practitioner , serve for a period of not less than five years and in such rural areas as the Government may by General or Special Orders specify.
- ii) Those candidates who fail to comply with clause 3 (i) shall have to pay a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) or as the Government may direct as penalty for having breached the Contract in the bond.
- 04) During the period of Internship under clause (2) and while in Service under clause (3) the candidate shall faithfully , diligently and with skill and ability perform his / her duties and observe the rules for the time being in force made by the Governor or the President as the case may be for regulating the conduct of Government Servants.
- 05) While in service under clause (3) the pay and allowance and other conditions of service of the candidate shall be regulated by the rules and orders of the Government for the time being in force, for the post to which he / she is appointed.
