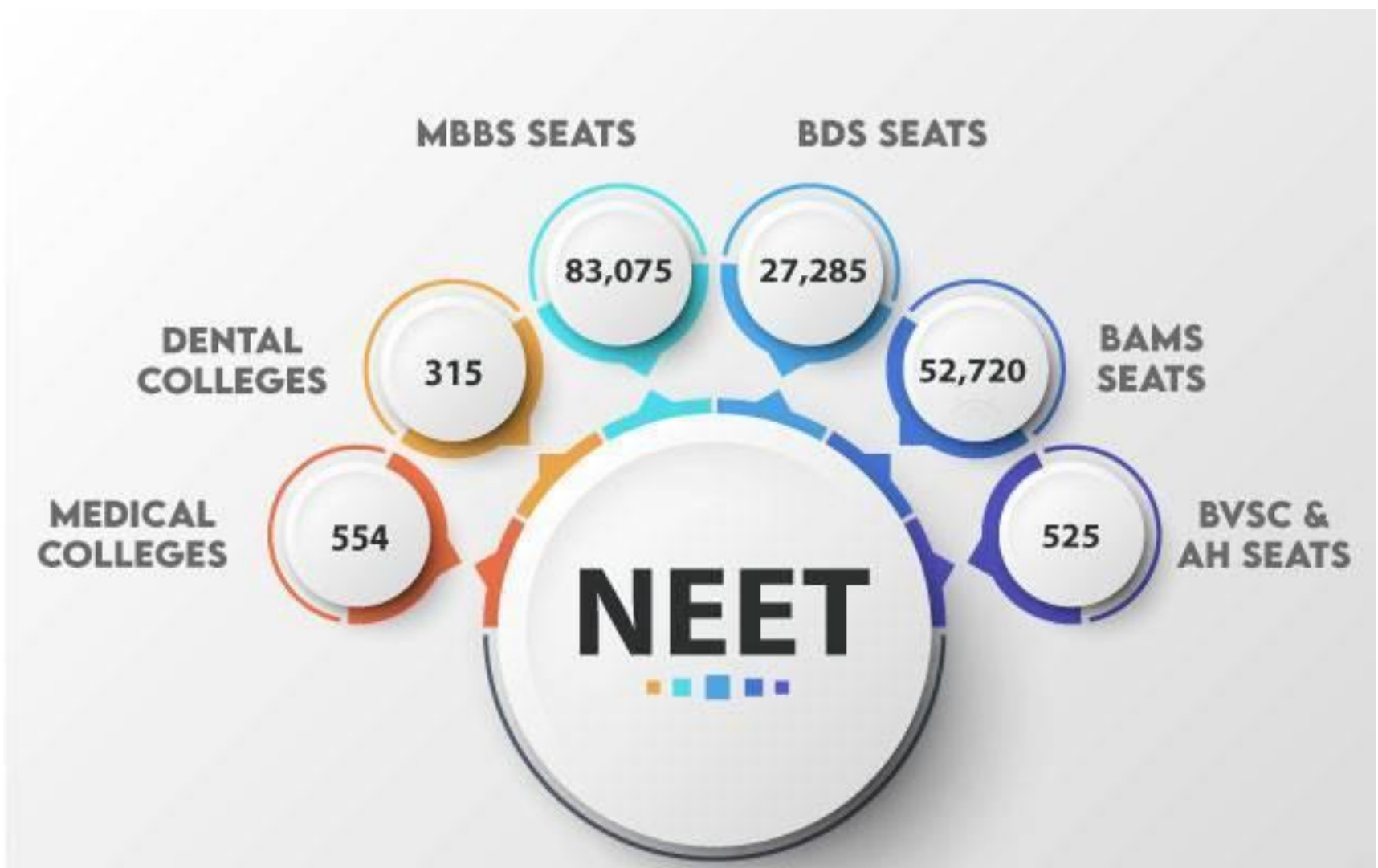

Major Factors to be considered while choosing a medical college

1. **Rank of the college in India** - *National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) commonly employed*
2. **Patient inflow**
3. **Faculty, Hospital Infrastructure Like Total In-Patient Beds, Super Specialty Departments**
4. **Location**
5. **Tuition Fees, Hostel Fees, Miscellaneous Fees**
6. **Age of the Medical College**
7. **Number of PG Courses**
8. **Compulsory Rural Service Years and Bond Penalty Amount**
9. **Internal Quota For Post Graduate Studies**
10. **Stipend During Clinical Rotation Internship**

Personal Factors to be considered while choosing a medical college

- **Whether you are comfortable in studying outside your hometown and sharing a room with others in a hostel.**
- **Whether you are okay with the fact that the city of your college may be too far from your home.**
- **Whether it is only the college that matters to you or there are other factors that you want to take into account as well.**

NMC Accreditation is an important factor

- **National Medical Commission (NMC) is the Indian regulatory body of 33 members which regulates medical education and medical professionals.**
- **It replaced the Medical Council of India on 25 September 2020.**
- **The Commission grants recognition of medical qualifications, gives accreditation to medical schools, grants registration to medical practitioners, and monitors medical practice and assesses the medical infrastructure in India.**

NIRF Ranking of Medical Colleges in India -2021

- **The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) is a methodology adopted by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, to rank institutions of higher education in India.**
- **Last year, only 120 medical colleges applied for evaluation out of the total 500+ medical colleges in India.**
- **Some of the premier state government medical colleges such as Stanley Medical College, Osmania Medical College, Gandhi Medical College, etc did not participate in the NIRF evaluation last year. So, it becomes difficult to know the quality and ranking of these remaining 450 Indian medical colleges.**
